Log In to Unified Platform

Logging In to RealPage Unified Platform for the First Time

Before you can log in to RealPage Unified Platform, a RealPage System Administrator must create an account for you. You will receive an email with a link to activate your account.

1. Select the link in the account activation email.
2. Set your **Password**.
3. Select **Save and Continue**.
4. Set security questions and answers.
5. Select **Submit**.



If your company uses RealPage multi-factor authentication, you might also be prompted to set up your authentication method.

Logging In to RealPage Unified Platform

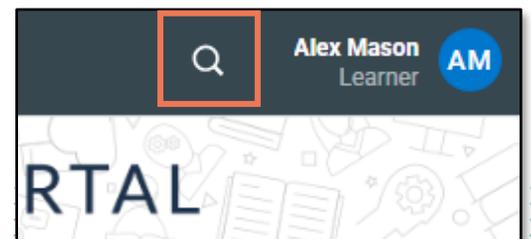
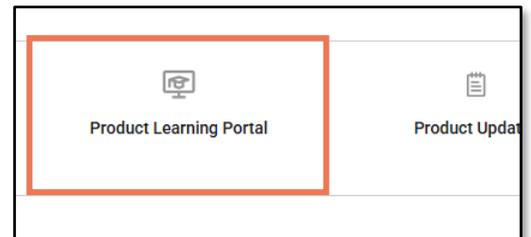
1. Go to <https://www.realpage.com/home>.
2. Enter your **Username**. If you are a regular user, external user, or RealPage system administrator, this is typically your primary email address.
3. Select **Next**.
4. The authentication that displays depends on your account's configuration. If prompted, enter your **Password**.
5. Select **Login**.



If your company uses a third-party identity service to authenticate your user account, log into that system to access RealPage Unified Platform.

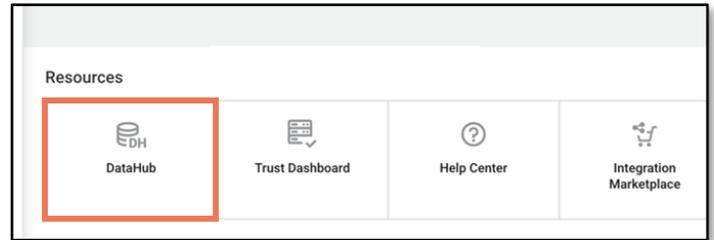

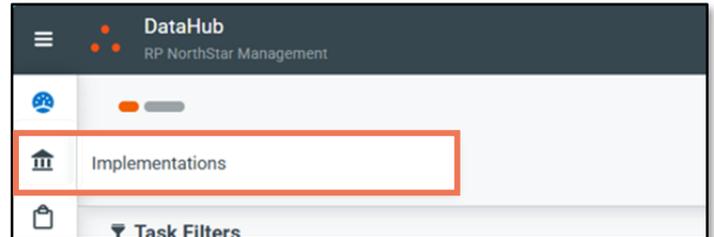


Access DataHub in Unified Platform

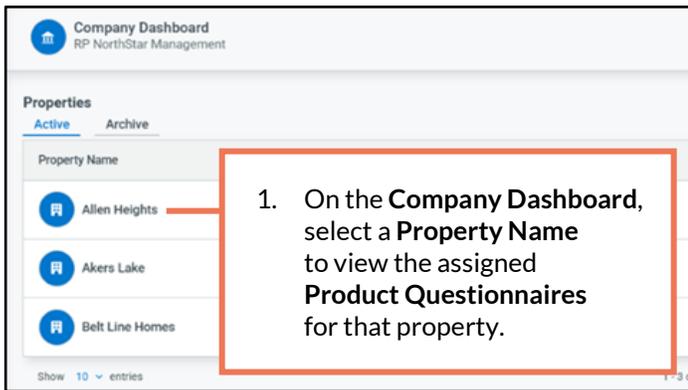
1. Log in to **Unified Platform**.
2. In the **Resources** section, select **DataHub**.



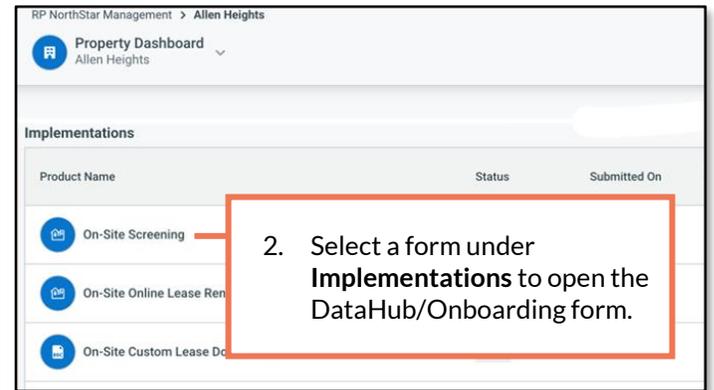
3. Upon accessing **DataHub**, it will default to the **Work Queue**.
4. Select **Implementations** from the left-hand side menu to complete assigned product questionnaires.



View Product Questionnaires



1. On the **Company Dashboard**, select a **Property Name** to view the assigned **Product Questionnaires** for that property.

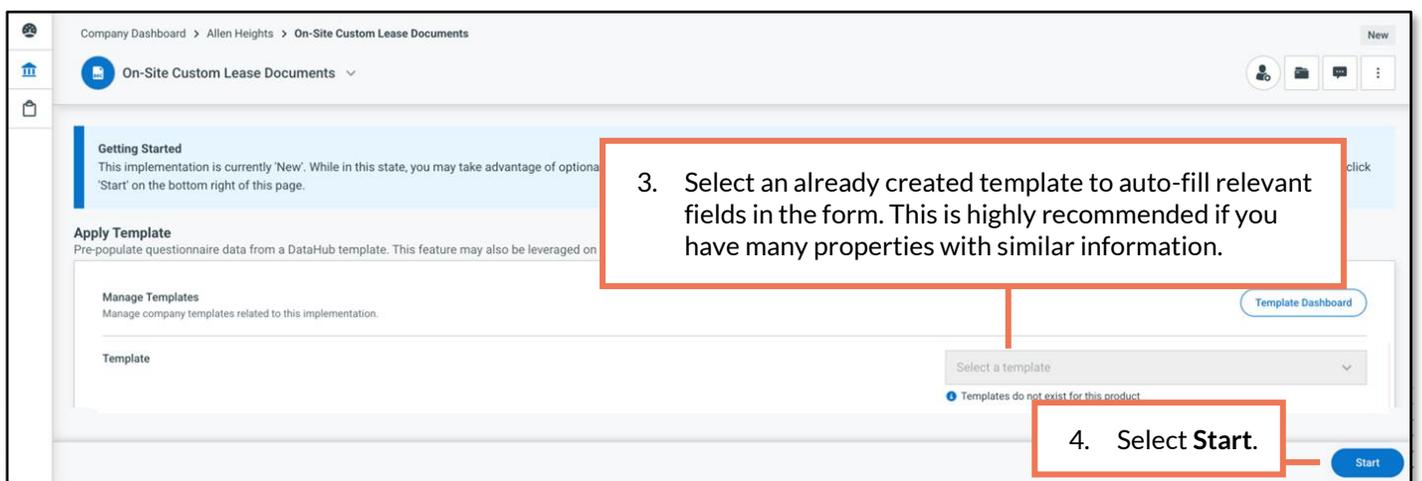


2. Select a form under **Implementations** to open the **DataHub/Onboarding** form.



Form Statuses:

- **New:** Form has not been started yet.
- **In Progress:** Form has been started but not submitted.
- **Under Review:** Form is complete and now on RealPage to review.



3. Select an already created template to auto-fill relevant fields in the form. This is highly recommended if you have many properties with similar information.

4. Select **Start**.

1. Select one of the options under **Page Summary** (red box) to start filling out the necessary info for each page.
2. Once all info is filled out, it should show **Valid** under **Validation Failures**.
3. Select **Submit** when done.
4. Confirm data is correct and note that the form will become read-only.
5. Repeat the steps for each form under the **Implementations** section for each property.
